1837 Barossa

2 hour Wine Experience (Vineyard Walk, History Movie, Wine Tasting like a Pro, 8 Wines Tastings, Gourmet Pizzas): 1837 Barossa commemorates the date on which Colonel William Light, founder of Adelaide and first Surveyor-General of South Australia, named the Barossa in December 1837. The Barossa Colonel Light Monument, a life-size bronze monument of Colonel Light on horseback and the iconic Barossa Manor, honour the birthplace of Barossa on the estate. A tribute to which 1837 wine makers dedicate their wines year after year. Upon arrival at 1837 Barossa estate, we will guide you to the VIP tasting room and show you a short movie about the naming of the Barossa, the history of Colonel William Light and our winery. We will then guide you to the Colonel Light Monument and you can enjoy the full 360-degree views from the historic point. You will be able to walk the art trail which allows you to take pictures of the many colourful sculptures which includes the "Wings of Barossa" where you can pose as an angel between two aiant winas that overlook the vineyards. Next, a guided vineyard walk where you learn all about grape growing and its terroir. If seasons permit, you will be able to sample some grapes. Back in the exclusive Pavilion you will receive an introduction in winemaking and you will learn how to taste wine like a professional. The wine experience will then be crowned by a tasting of 8 white and red wines, which will include the reserve range and sparkling. Then move to our roman terrace and have a pizza and a glass of your favourite wine. \$99
